Dear Parents / Carers

Activity week is nearly upon us and we are all excited about the wonderful activities that will be taking place. We wanted to let you know further details about the trips planned for the week and what the children will need on each day. Although the majority of the cost will be met by the school, please may we ask for a **voluntary contribution of £10**? This can be paid in instalments of £5 if this is easier. Please may we ask you to return the permission slip below and return it to your child's class teacher, along with your contribution in a sealed envelope by Monday 23rd May.

Monday 6th June

On Monday we will be enjoying a morning of mini golf at Strokes Mini Golf in Westbrook. We will be leaving school at approximately 9.30 am to walk to Strokes. After the mini golf the children will get the opportunity to choose an ice lolly before walking back to school. **No additional money will be needed.**

Tuesday 7th June

On Tuesday we plan to spend the morning cooking, making pizzas and fruit salad. The children will enjoy eating these together for their lunch. Therefore they will not need to bring in a packed lunch or pay for a school dinner.

All of the usual pizza toppings will be available for the children to choose from, however, if your child has a particular preference for their pizza toppings they will be asked to bring these in for themselves in a named container. We do also please ask parents to provide their child with an apron for this activity.

Wednesday 8th June

On Wednesday we are excited to inform you that we will be joining many schools from the area at the East Kent Science Jamboree. There will be two groups, one morning and one afternoon, each group will be travelling in the school minibus. The morning group will be leaving school promptly at **8.45 am** to travel to Pfizers, **(please make sure your child is in school by 8.30am)**. The afternoon group should arrive home in time for the normal end of school, we will keep parents updated of any changes.

Thursday 9th June

On Thursday morning, we will be walking to the Turner Centre on Margate seafront. We will be met by one of the education guides and will tour the art gallery. We will also be taking part in some hands-on art activities with one of the gallery guides during the tour. We will be returning back to school by lunchtime.

Friday 10th June

On Friday we will be enjoying a day out at Howletts Zoo. We will be leaving school at 9.30 am and returning to school at approximately 3.45 pm. We will be travelling by minibus. We would ask that your child wears suitable shoes for walking around the park, brings a waterproof coat in case of inclement weather, has a packed lunch and brings extra drinks (not fizzy). If your child normally has a **free school meal**, and you would like one provided, then please indicate on the attached permission slip. Your child may bring £5 spending money in a sealed envelope or purse, for which they will be responsible.

For all trips during activity week please refer to the points below:

- School uniform must be worn at all times.
- Please ensure your child brings a spare bottle of water, especially if the weather is warm.
- Please ensure that your child is suitably prepared for walking in all weather conditions, as we know that our weather can be unpredictable. (Children will need comfortable shoes, sun cream, sunhat/cap and a raincoat).
- PE kit needs to stay in school all week.
- Please may we ask you to be aware of Friday's later return time and be available to meet your child at 3.45pm or indicate if they are allowed to walk home.

We are sure that you will agree that this should be an exciting week for the children and we look forward to the activities ahead. If there are any queries regarding the details in this letter, please do come and speak to us.
