Entry into the School Building

Absence from school

If your child is going to be off school due to ill health please ensure you telephone the school office before 9.30am on a daily basis. Evidence may be requested, such as a doctor's prescribed medication label or a medical appointment letter/card. We do ask that parents/carers where possible make all appointments outside of the school day

Lost Property

The lost property is once again overflowing! Unfortunately, none of the items are named. Please check with Mrs Palmer, at the end of the school day in KS2, if your child has lost anything. To avoid more lost property in the future, PLEASE ensure that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled/marked.

Earrings and PE Kit

Please be aware that only small stud earrings are suitable for school wear, and these must be taken out by the child before PE (or before school by a parent or carer on the days that your child has PE). Please ensure that your child always has their correct kit in school for the days that they do PE.

Parent and Teacher Consultation

As you are aware our Parent and Teacher Consultation afternoon will be taking place on **Wednesday 11th November from 2:40pm – 7:30pm.**

Reception, Year 1 and 2 will be based in the KS2 hall and Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be in their classrooms. The Maths group teachers, Mr Cope and Mrs Northrop will be in the KS2 hall as well as the Headteacher.

You will need to book your appointment with your child's class teacher in advance. Clipboards with time slots will be available in the KS1 and KS2 playgrounds and the Year 6 entrance from Monday 2nd November up until the morning of Friday 6th November.

On the day of the consultation **children will finish their school day at 2:25pm** and the gates will be open from 2:15pm.
