

# **Keeping Healthy at Garlinge**

## The Curriculum

#### Year

During Term 3, we will be finding out about toys and games. We will be using different styles and techniques in Design and Technology to make toys and games.

n Science we will be finding out about materials—what old and new toys are made from and exploring their properties. We will also make and explore musical instruments.

In Term 4 we will be learning all about

Dinosaurs.. We will be finding out about where and when they lived. We will learn about the different types of dinosaurs and what they looked like. We will also be learning about fossils and how people know they existed. In Science we will be looking at the seasons and weather.

#### Year 2

During Term 3 we are learning about space. We will focus upon the earth, our solar system and space exploration. We will be using the book 'Man on the Moon' as our stimulus

for the topic. In Science we will be learning about Sir Isaac Newton.

Our topic in Term 4 is about Night time. In this topic we will be learning about the night time environment, night time jobs and nocturnal animals.

In Science we will be learning about plants. We will be looking at the different variety of plants and how they grow. We will be visiting the Garlinge Community Allotment throughout the term. During our visits we will also explore the different wildlife within our local area.

Top Tip: When you read with your child

Help your child to learn and achieve their best by helping them with their learning at home.
Help them to practice their times tables (2,5,and 10s) and number bonds to 10 and 20 daily (two numbers that add up to 10 or 20).

Every child should be reading at home on a daily
