Allocations

National Offer day - Friday 1st March 2019 an email will be sent to you after 4:00pm telling you which school you have been offered.

You must accept or decline the school place you've been offered between 2nd March and 15th March 2019

Appeals

- Parents have the right to request reallocation for schools listed higher than the school which has been allocated.
- If you were unsuccessful in your choice of school the arrangements for appealing for a place at the school of your choice will be included with the letter.
- Appeals must be received at County between 1st March and 29th March 2019
- Each oversubscribed school will keep a waiting list where children will be placed in order according to the school's oversubscription criteria.
- Let the school know you have accepted the place
