Dear Parents & Carers,

This is the first newsletter of the school year, but I would like to wish everyone a big 'Welcome back' to school and I hope that you all enjoyed a relaxing summer holiday. The children have been in school now for a number of weeks and are really progressing well with their learning. I am also pleased to report that, in the vast majority of classes, attendance is very good and I hope that this continues. This is a big focus for the school and as many studies have found, if children miss a significant amount of time in school (attendance BELOW 95%) it can and will affect not only their learning but also their socialisation and friendship groups.

It has been lovely walking the site and seeing the children enjoying their indoor and outdoor environments. We have invested significantly in our outdoor environment, and will continue to do so that that our children have access to the resources that they deserve. Over the summer, as well as updating much of the paintwork around the school, we also replaced the fairly old lighting system with modern LED lights which produce light more conducive to learning as well as being much more eco-friendly. Please could I ask that you ensure that your children continue to respect all areas and resources within school so that they keep looking as good as they do currently.

It is also noticeable how many of our parents and carers are supporting their child's learning at home, through homework activities, reading, times tables etc. This really is very beneficial for the children when they come in to school and I would like to thank everybody who currently does this. Pupils are encouraged to arrive at school by 8:45am for registration at 8:55am. The school gates are shut promptly. All pupils that arrive late must report, with their parent, to the school office where the time of arrival and the reason for lateness is recorded. for KS1 pupils and from 3.15pm for KS2 pupils - Children should **ONLY** be collected from the main school office in exceptional circumstances.

School Dinners

Principals Catering would like to remind parents of children in **Years 3 to 6** that school meals **MUST** be paid for **IN ADVANCE**. This has to be on the child's first school day of the week, for all of the days that the child needs to have a meal provided. **You will be unable to pay daily**. If your child does not pay at the beginning of the week, you will be contacted and asked to provide a packed lunch.

School dinners are £2.15 per day, £10.75 per week.

<u>Healthy Lunches</u>

Job Vacancies - Midday Meals Supervisor and Road Crossing Patrol

We currently have a vacancy for a Midday Meals Supervisor working 10 hours a week to support our children at lunchtime. The hours are from 11.20am to 13.20pm, 5 days a week, term time only (38 weeks per year). The pay is approximately £7.22 per hour.

We also have a vacancy for a Road Crossing Patrol (RCP) team member. We rely on the skills of our RCP to keep our children safe on their journey to and from school.

The start and finish times are 8.25am to 9.00am for the morning duty and 14.55pm to 15.30pm for the afternoon duty, 5 days a week, term time only (38 weeks per year). The pay is approximately £7.22 per hour.
