Parent and Carer contact details



We have noticed an increase in the number of cars parked on the pavement around the gate by the KS1




NO PARKING PLEASE

Parking all around the premises needs to be considerate of our neighbours and the law. Regular patrols by a Traffic Warden have resulted in several parking tickets being issued – **beware.**

Please do not let your children walk across the school car parks, it is **DANGEROUS!**

If you do have to drive your child to school, please park in a safe place away from the entrance and:

- Keep the bus and taxi layby clear
- Drive at a suitable speed in case children run onto the road
- Meet your children at the school gate and walk them safely to your car
- Please use the recommended crossing paths with the Road Crossing Patrol



Attendance

Please may we remind all parents that children leaving before the end of the school day **MUST** be kept to a minimum and only under exceptional circumstances. Frequently, the end of the lesson is when the teacher re-caps and important information is given to the children. As your children's education is a priority, any appointments should, wherever possible, be made out of school time and in the event of this not being possible, we would like to request that both the class teacher and school office are notified as soon as possible prior to the appointment and a copy of an appointment card or hospital letter brought in as evidence.
