Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are all aware the children are enjoying their Forest School sessions and are learning many new skills.

We have been fortunate enough to be offered a day at Beach School as part of this. We will be exploring the beach, rock pools, playing team games and other exciting things. The children will attend Beach School, based at Westbrook Beach, instead of Forest School.

We are planning to go during the week beginning 24th June 2019 and it will be on your child's usual Forest School day, which are as follows:-

Monday 24th June – RA, Miss Stannard's class

Tuesday 25th June – RD, Miss Mutton's class

Wednesday 26th June – RC, Mrs Keegan's class

Friday 28th June – RB, Mrs McLevy's class

Your child will need to dress appropriately for the weather and for the beach. Please make sure you have applied sun cream and provided a hat for your child. They will also need appropriate footwear, such as sandals or old trainers and they may need a towel as we will be exploring rock pools. They **DO NOT** need swimwear.

You will need to make sure you provide your child with a lunch and plenty to drink, unless provided by the school.

If the weather does not lend itself to a day on the beach the children will attend a normal Forest School session.
