### Covid 19 Reporting during the Easter Break

Dear Parents and Carers,

If your child develops symptoms of coronavirus between **now** and **Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> April** and was in school on **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> March and Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April** and has a **POSITIVE** Covid-19 test result, please use one of the options below to notify the school. This may result in a notification being sent by the school to other parents and carers informing them that their child will need to isolate for a given period.

If your child develops symptoms from **Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> April**, you do not need to notify the school during the Easter break as your child would not have been in contact with their class during their infectious period.

Please note that the school has been advised to monitor the Covid-19 positive test emails once a day through to **7<sup>th</sup> April**. Therefore you do not need to notify the school beyond this date as all positive Covid-19 cases should be dealt with through NHS Test and Trace.

**Only contact us if your child develops symptoms on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> or Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> April and has a POSITIVE test result.**
