Forest School

As part of the provision within Reception, we aim to offer a variety of learning experiences for your children. As a result of this, we are very pleased to let you know that after Easter <u>ALL</u> children in Reception will attend a FREE 10 week course at the Manor House Forest School Site, based within the grounds of Quex Park.

Each class will visit the Forest School for one day per week, from the beginning of May until the end of the summer term in July. Most of the children will be visiting on the same day each week, although there are a couple of changes that we will inform you of.

The cost of the visits will be met in full by the school, and transport will also be provided so that the children will come to and from school at the normal time each day.

In order to ensure that everyone is fully prepared for the exciting sessions, we will be running a parent information session to answer any questions you may have. At this session I will be present, as well as Stuart Welby, Lead Practitioner at the Forest School, and members of the Foundation staff team.

We will also outline the clothing requirements and clarify lunch arrangements.

This meeting will be held on <u>Wednesday 11th March at 2:30pm</u>. The meeting will be in the Key Stage 1 hall, via the Caxton Road entrance. Once the meeting has ended you will be able to take your child home.
