

EYFS Home Learning Timetable – Week starting 13.7.20

Monday

Literacy Clever Hands

Home learning focus:

To use a controlled movement

Today we are going to take part in Clever Hands activities. Ask your child if they can tell you what Clever Hands is and what it is for.

We do Clever Hands to build the strength and control in our fingers so we can do lots of different things with our hands.

Nursery Phonics – Today we are going to be finding rhyming pairs using the page in our learning pack. Talk about one of the words on the cone, discussing what it is. Go through each of the words on the ice cream asking your child if they rhyme/sound the same. Can they match them all up?

Reception Phonics – Recap your child's sounds and tricky words. Play Tricky Word Trucks. Select Phase 2 and 3 together. <https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/2/tricky-word-trucks> Support your child to build the tricky words with their yellow sound cards (Phase 3 – *he, she, we, me, be, was, you, they, all, are*). Can they copy the word? Once they have it written, can they cover it and have a go at writing it by themselves?

Activity 1

Sock Throw

Choose a starting position then see how far can you throw your ball of socks. Measure your throw to the nearest cm! If you do not have a tape measure count how many steps (heel to toe).

Tuesday

Literacy Transition

Home learning focus:

To use talk to organise ideas

Today we will be sharing the story – ‘The Cautious Caterpillar’ by Twinkl.

If you have access to Twinkl you can share the PowerPoint version on their website.

Share the story with your child, pausing to ask them questions, for example:

- Do you know another story about a caterpillar?

- Where do you think Cody lives?

- What will happen to Cody when she gets older?

You can find more questions and picture references in our pack.

Talk about the key characters in the story (Cody, the ladybird, the bee, the grasshopper). With your child, can you draw the characters to make puppets? Use the puppets to retell the story. Encourage your child to talk about each event in the story. Talk about the settings. Can you find things to represent the different settings?

Nursery Phonics – Match Sounds

Click on the sound button. Can your child identify what made the sound?

Reception Phonics – Recap your child’s sounds and tricky words.

Share some pictures (these can be found in the pack) and support your child to build the word with their sounds.

Can they write the word themselves? Can they think of a sentence with the word in it?

Activity 2 and 3

Sock Catch

Throw your ball of socks into the air and see how many times you can clap before you catch them. You get 1 point for every clap you do - remember you have to catch the socks to score!

Sock Keepy Uppies

Can you keep your ball of socks up in the air using just your feet or just your hands? How many keepy uppies can you do in 1 minute? If you drop your socks, don't worry keep going and keep adding your score!

Wednesday

Literacy Transition

Home learning focus:

To talk in full sentences

Recap the story of the Cautious Caterpillar from yesterday. Share the following video with your child, pausing if needed to discuss each section.

Reception – This video is to support your child’s transition to Year 1. Encourage your child to engage and discuss how they feel and to think of things that they might enjoy when they go to their new class.

Nursery – If you have a child who will be remaining in Nursery, then you can change the wording from ‘new class’ to talk about their return to Nursery. Encourage them to engage and discuss how they feel and to think of things that they might enjoy when they go back to Nursery.

Nursery Phonics – What’s Behind The Door?

Can your child name the animal that is hiding behind the door by their sound?

Reception Phonics – Today we are going to be reading captions and drawing a picture to match them. In the home learning pack you can find some pictures and captions from Phase 2. Support your child to blend and read the captions and talk about what they have read. Can they draw the matching picture? If your child is confident with this they can have a go at the Phase 3 page.

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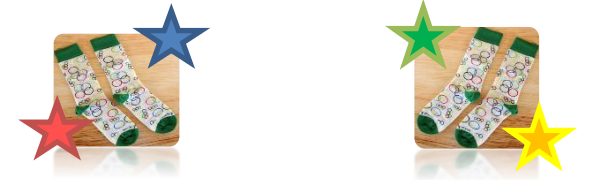

Activity 4 and 5

Sock Basketball

Put a bucket or laundry basket 4m or 4 big steps away. How many times can you throw your ball of socks into the bucket, collect, return and throw again in 1 minute?

Sock Bowling

Set up 6 skittles (toilet roll tubes or empty bottles/cans). Stand 3m or 3 big steps away & use your ball of socks to knock them down! How many can you knock down in 3 separate throws? Score 1 point for each knock down.

Thursday

Literacy Transition

Home learning focus:

To write in simple sentences / To talk in simple sentences

Today we are going to be focussing on the positives of the changes coming in September, like the butterfly ended up doing in our story.

In our learning pack, you can find a transition butterfly to complete. Encourage your child to talk in full sentences about each of the sections. Can they give their reasons why?

Reception – Support your child to use their sounds to write their responses. Sound mats can be found in our learning pack also.

Nursery – Adult to scribe.

We have also included another transition activity in our home learning pack to support your child further if they are feeling worried or nervous.

Activity 6 and 7

Sock Jump

Place your ball of socks on the floor and see how many times you can jump over them and back in 1 minute!

Give yourself 1 point for every jump!

Rainbow Sock

Throw

Put your socks into one hand & throw to your other, like a rainbow arch! How many rainbows can you throw in 1 minute?

Friday

Literacy Reading

Home learning focus:

To blend phonemes to read / To share stories with interest

Nursery – Share a story with your child. Ask them to tell you what they think might happen next and why? Can they identify the main character? Ask them to identify something in the picture. Can they tell you what happened in the story when it is finished? What was their favourite part?

Please ensure that you stay within their current book band so that they can build their confidence in reading to you. You can ask the key questions from above.
