

Create your very own colourful jellyfish that you can hang from the ceiling or in your windows so passersby can marvel at your aquatic masterpieces! You just need a paper plate, some paint and some colourful string.



#### <u>Maths:</u>

When you're out for your walk try collecting a variety of shells which, when washed, you can turn into a fun maths game. Simply write different numbers on the underside of the shell, turn them over and try to match the numbers. This could be done with the digit (10) and word (ten), or by adding the two numbers up to make number bonds of 10, 20 and beyond!



## Phonics:

Instead of recycling any empty plastic bottles you have why not turn them into a fun Phonics bowling game? Simply choose the sound you want to focus on, for example 'ai' and tape different words with this sound in to each bottle. Set them up like bowling pins and roll a pair of balled up socks at them. Any bottle you knock over you have to read the attached to it and for every one you get right you get a point. This could be used for tricky words too!
