Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 6 (Current Year 4) Residential Trip Grosvenor Hall, Kingswood 27th to 29th September 2023

I am writing to inform you of our proposal for a residential trip for your child when they reach Year 6.

I am pleased to be able to tell you that we have secured a provisional booking at Grosvenor Hall, near Ashford, between Wednesday 27th and Friday 29th September 2023. Grosvenor Hall is part of the Kingswood group for outdoor learning and the accommodation offers adventure and recreational facilities set in the grounds of a former manor house and allows for a very wide range of activities, all supervised by fully qualified instructors. We have used this site for our current year 6 and both the accommodation and facilities are of a high standard.

We will be holding a meeting when we return in September for both parents and carers of children who would be interested in taking part once they reach year 6. During the meeting there will be a presentation regarding the location and all that it offers and a chance to speak with staff who have attended previously. The meeting will be at 5:30pm on 5th October and will be held in the KS2 hall. Entry will be via the main entrance on Westfield Road.

The cost of the trip will be £190.00 and a deposit of £50 will be required to secure a place for your child.
