#### **KEY STAGE ONE**

School gates open at 8.45am. Registration at 8.55am. School finishes at 3.10pm.

#### **Punctuality**

The KSI doors open at 8:45am and this is a chance for your child to come into school and hang up their coat and take part in a learning activity before registration. The register is taken at 8:55am, any child that arrives after this time will be marked as being late. When a child is late for school they miss out both socially and academically and feel they are not part of the lessons. We would ask you to ensure your child is brought to school ready to start their day between 8:45am and 8:55am everyday.
