If your child is feeling confident why not try and create your own game where you need to take turns.





There are many ways you can do this, and you can tailor the activity to your child's interests. You could chalk the numbers on the floor, you could get them to paint the numbers, or use a paint brush and water on concrete outside. You could get them to write using their finger in sand, rice, foam etc. Or you could use paper or our example sheet that can be found in the pack. We are going to be focusing on numerals to 10 – don't worry if your child finds this challenging. 
