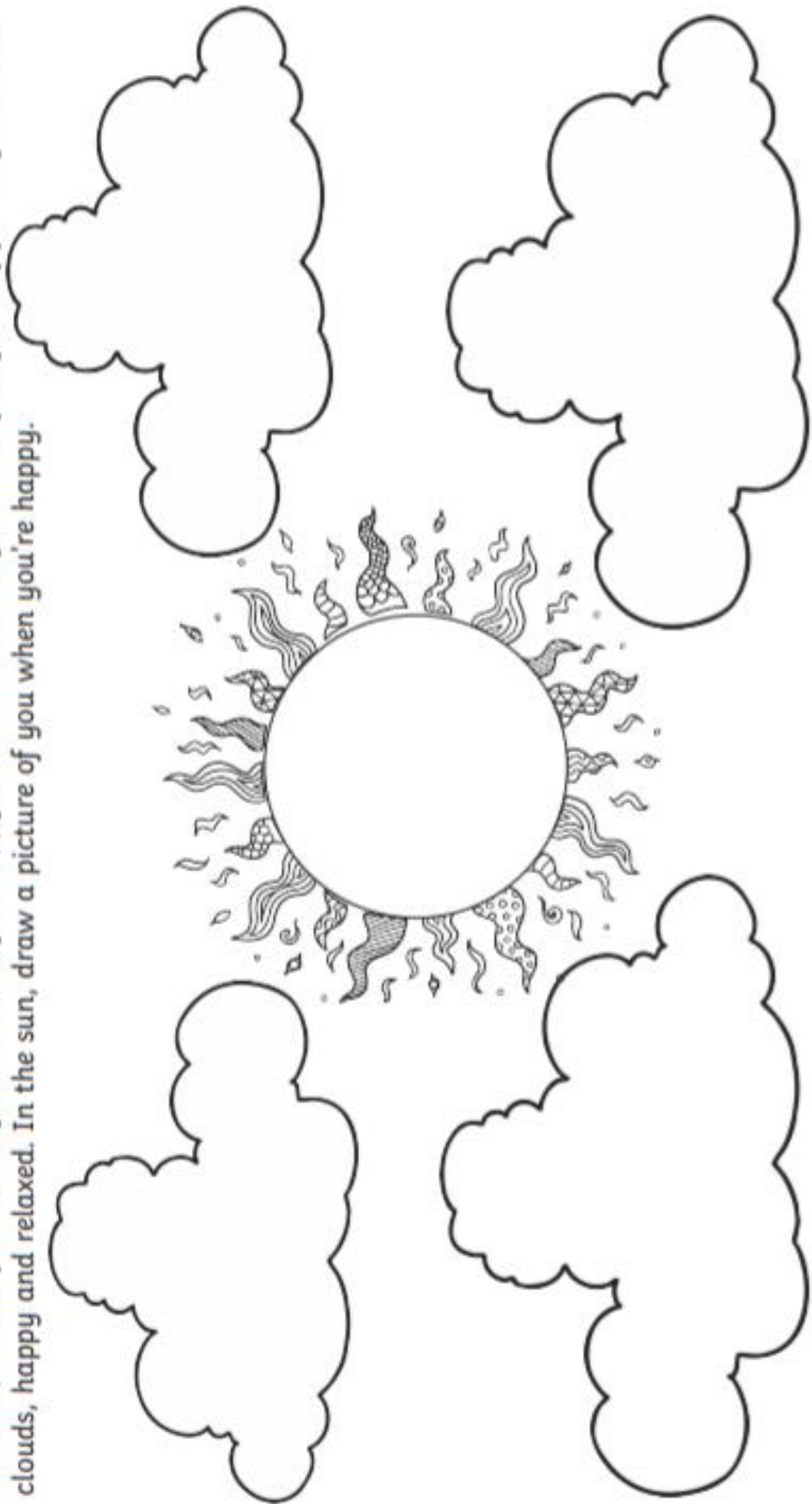






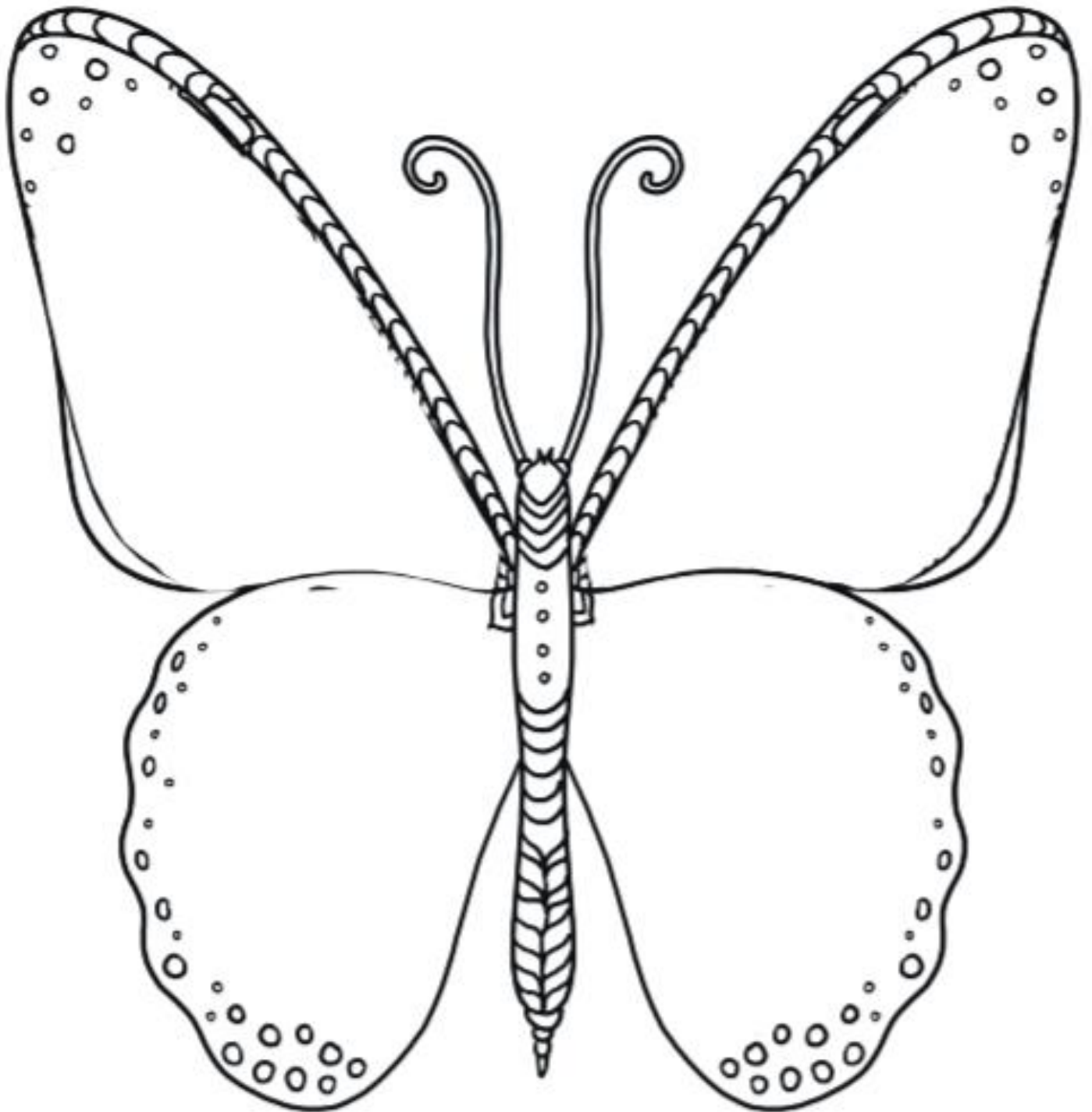
I Am Happy When...
