Dear Parents and Carers,

Overleaf is the club timetable for Term 4, February -April. If you would like to sign up to any of the clubs relevant to your child's year group please indicate on the form attached.

Please read through the following information carefully and return the completed forms by **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> February**, as any forms after this date will not be accepted.

You will receive a text by the week beginning 11<sup>th</sup> February, if your child has a place on any of the clubs that require a sign up. This will inform you when they will start, so please ensure the office has the correct mobile number. **Please note that you must have received confirmation before your child can start the club.**

I would be grateful if you would carefully read the below agreement form as when signing your child up for clubs you are agreeing to the after school club agreement statements.

I understand and agree that:

- ❖ ALL children who have a place in after school clubs will be expected to attend, unless their parent or carer has either contacted the SCHOOL OFFICE or has sent a signed letter in to school to inform us that they cannot attend.
- ❖ Non-attendance will be reviewed and may mean losing the place.
- ❖ School rules and sanctions for behaviour will apply.
- ❖ If my child is late being collected the school will try to contact me.
- ❖ If you have stated that your child will make their own way home they will be expected to leave school premises promptly at the end of the club.
- ❖ Please help us keep your child safe by informing the school should any changes occur with any of these arrangements. I will ensure that any payments required for after school clubs will be handed in prior to the club starting.
