- How will adverbs and adjectives help in your sentences?

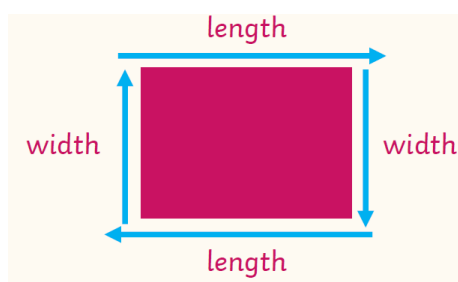
Maths

Focus - To calculate the perimeter of a rectangle.

Today, we will be looking at strategies to calculate the perimeter of a rectangle.

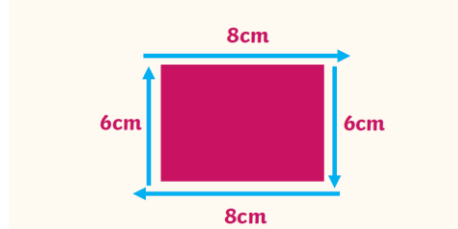
There are two main strategies that we can use to calculate the perimeter of a rectangle.

Strategy 1: add all the lengths and widths together, the answer will be the perimeter of the shape.



Strategy 2: add the length and width together and then multiply by 2.

$$\text{Perimeter} = 2 \times \text{length} + 2 \times \text{width}$$



Can you use strategies 1 and 2 to answer the set maths questions? Remember to check your working out and answer when you finish.

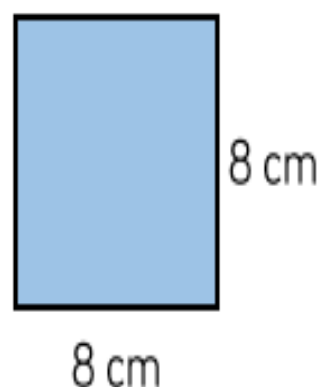
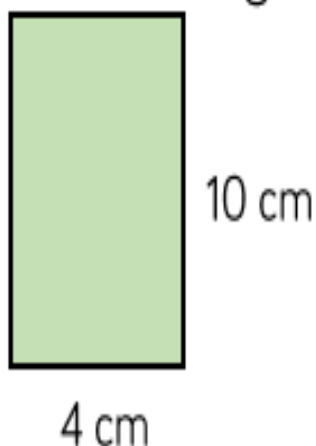
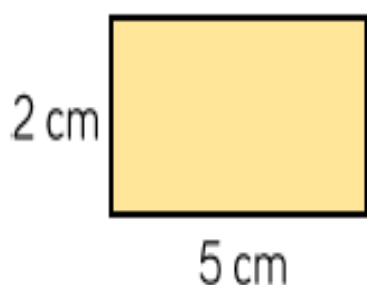

Calculate the perimeter of the rectangles.

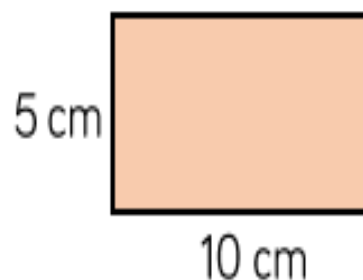


$$___ \text{ cm} + ___ \text{ cm} + ___ \text{ cm} + ___ \text{ cm} = ___ \text{ cm}$$

Eva is finding the perimeter of the rectangle.



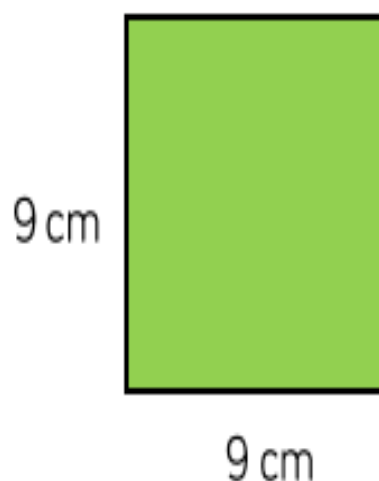
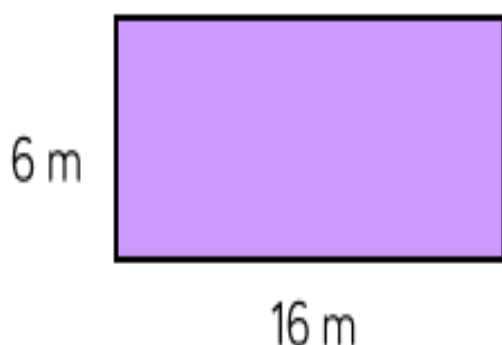
I added the length and width together and then multiplied by 2

Use Eva's method to find the perimeter of the rectangles.



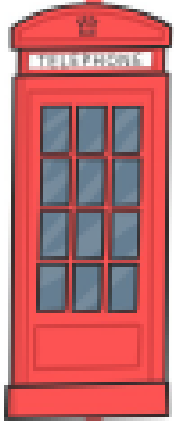
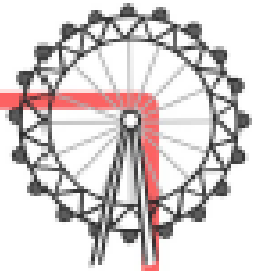
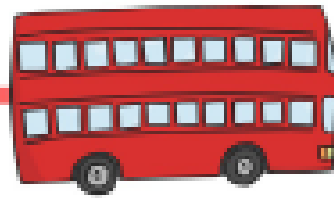
