Also on Wednesday, there will be arts and crafts activities.

Thursday 28th September

On Thursday, we have some PE and sports visitors. The children will be having a fun morning filled with sporting activities.

On Thursday afternoon, we will have a movie and treats afternoon.

Friday 29th September

On Friday, we plan to spend the morning taking part in a musical jamboree – this will be led by Mr Cowan - our music lead teacher. We will also be taking part in cookie decorating and have the opportunity to eat them whilst at school.

On Friday afternoon, there will be sports activities on the field led by our PE staff.

For our trip to Strokes Mini Golf please refer to the points below:

- Children to wear their school PE t-shirt and a school cardigan or jumper, alongside plain dark shorts, leggings, or joggers.
- Ensure your child brings a spare bottle of water, especially if the weather is warm.
- Ensure that your child is suitably prepared for walking in all weather conditions, as we know that
 our weather can be unpredictable (children will need comfortable shoes, sun cream, sunhat/cap
 and a raincoat)
