At this stage of year 5, children of 'average' mathematical and reading ability should be working at band 29 or 30. They should also have an approximate standardised score of 100. However, those looking to secure places in grammar schools should ordinarily be already working at, or above, band 31 and have an approximate standardised score of 110 or above. However, due to Covid-19 and potential 'lost learning' these bands may be lower than normal this year.
